Alberta residents who are 65 years of age or older who have valid Alberta Health Care Insurance Plan (AHCIP) coverage are eligible for premium-free Coverage for Seniors administered by Alberta Blue Cross. To receive this benefit, an Alberta Health agent must have received proof of your age and validate it in the health system. Once your age is validated, Alberta Blue Cross will issue your benefits card.

To submit proof of your age, please complete this form with a clear, legible photocopy of one of the following documents:

- Alberta driver's license or identification (ID) card
- birth certificate
- old-age pension entitlement form
- passport or immigration record
- Canadian citizenship certificate

Please DO NOT send originals as we cannot guarantee their safe return.

Completed proof of age forms and documentation can be submitted through one of the following options:

- Online: Visit seniors-housing.alberta.ca/submit-documents
- In person at a registry: Bring completed form and clear, legible photocopies of your documents to an Alberta Health care Insurance Plan participating registry agent. www.alberta.ca/ahcip-registry-locations
- Mail in: Send in your completed form and clear, legible photocopies of your documents to Alberta Health PO Box 1360 STN Main, Edmonton AB, T5J 2N3.
